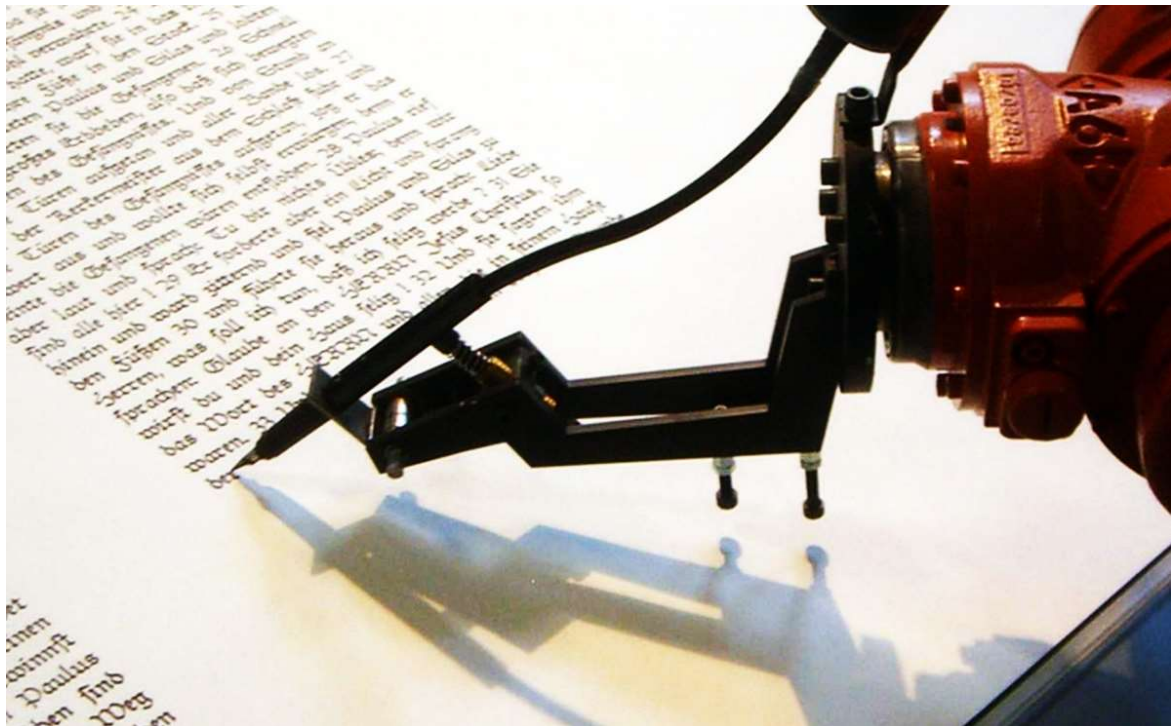


The future of sports journalism
